Case Study

Client: 16g Pavilion, Chavasse Park, Liverpool One

SCOPE OF WORKS:

All joinery works to pavilion prior to handover of building to end user. The proposed use being bistro/coffee shop.

WORKS INCLUDED:

- Treated softwood framing to steel construction of walls and deck areas.
- Marine plywood fixed to framing to all non-horizontal areas.
- Cladding of plywood in European oak machined to given dimensions.
- Deck areas constructed with treated timber joists and profiled European oak machined to given dimensions.

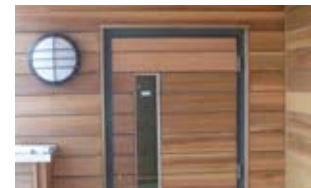
Client: Sefton Water Centre, Crosby Marina

SCOPE OF WORKS:

New building to facilitate water sport activities on the marina lake with an emphasis on inclusion and full provision of disabled facilities.

WORKS INCLUDED:

- Manufacture and installation of all internal doors and frames including veneered, laminated and PVC wrapped door leaves.
- Manufacture and installation of internal sapele framed fire rated glazed screens.
- Manufacture and installation of cedar cladding to the envelope of the building and container screening.
- Construction of structural timber walls to provide a substrate for the external cladding.
- Manufacture and installation of all external decking and joisting, and cladding to form a container screen.

Client: **Harris Museum**

SCOPE OF WORKS:

Refurbishment of display galleries and upgrading of existing doors to meet current building regulations.

WORKS INCLUDED:

- Enabling works – protection to major architectural elements of this listed building.
- Forming fire rated stud wall from ground floor to roof level within existing lift shaft.
- Refurbishment and up rating of doors, installation of new floor springs to meet fire rating requirements.
- Manufacture and installation of internal doors to gallery areas matching existing doors to meet strict English Heritage requirements.
- Installation of new entrance doors and frame
- Manufacture and installation of counter and backfittings to new retail area in entrance foyer.



- Forming of stud walls constructing new kitchen and toilet areas.
- Repairs to Pitch Pine flooring.

SCOPE OF WORKS:

Complete refurbishment of old public baths to produce a building for use as a local government One Stop Shop.

WORKS INCLUDED:

- replacement of barrel vaulted roofs and pediments, dormers and skylights.
- fascia, soffits and refurbishment of box guttering.
- manufacture and installation of oak glazed screens with integrated blinds.
- forming of reception area and interview rooms
- manufacture and installation of counters and backfittings.
- manufacture and installation of all internal joinery.
- manufacture and installation of oak window frames.
- manufacture and installation of washroom cubicle systems.
- refurbishment of lantern light.

- Construct structural timber framing to dormer roof lights.
- Supply and install all timber skirting boards.
- Manufacture and installation of all doors and frames with integral architraves.
- Supply and installation of all specified ironmongery.
- Manufacture and installation of all IPS units to toilet and wash hand basin areas.

Case Study

Client: The Great Space, Liverpool Anglican Cathedral

SCOPE OF WORKS:

Construction of new cafe area, mezzanine floor and retail space.

WORKS INCLUDED:

- Installation of timber joists between steel frame and plywood to provide substrate for floor finish.
- Manufacture and fitting of toilet cubicles, IPS panels and vanity units.
- Forming of lighting bulkhead and handrail to stairs.
- Oak treads, landing and handrail to steel staircase to main shop area.
- Oak panelling reinstatement to lower ground meeting room.
- Parquet flooring reinstatement to lower ground area.
- Construction of new lower ground office area.

- Installation of rooflights, central cupola and finials to barns.
- Manufacture and installation of all internal doors and frames including veneered and MDF faced door leaves.
- Supply and installation of kitchen units.
- Manufacture and installation of oak bi-fold entrance screens.
- Supply and installation of all uPVC windows and doors to CSB.
